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Are you eligible?

Domestic Students

Enrollment and Waiver Details

- This plan provides coverage from 8/15/15-8/14/16.
- Students enrolled in 12 or more credit hours are automatically enrolled and a charge of \$1,745 is added to their tuition bill.
- Domestic Students can opt-out of the Student Health Insurance Plan with comparable health insurance.
 - An online waiver form must be completed and submitted by September, 15 2015.
 Students can waive coverage by completing an online waiver at christiestudenthealth. com/mmc after June 29th, 2015.
 - The insurance charge will be removed from tuition bills after students successfully complete the online waiver.
