## **Introduction**

Marymount Manhattan College became the home of the Geraldine Anne Ferraro Papers because Ferraro is a member of the Class of 1956. On March 12, 2004, Marymount Manhattan completed the processing of political papers documenting Ferraro's three terms in Congress, her 1984 vice presidential candidacy, and her 1992 campaign to win the New York State Democratic Party primary and thus become the party's nominee for a seat in the United States Senate. Marymount Manhattan completed the processing of the photographs accompanying that initial deposition of papers on June 29, 2004. Then, on November 29, 2005, Ferraro deposited material documenting her work in the 1990s, and it is this deposit that is covered in this finding guide.

The year after her unsuccessful vice-presidential run, Ferraro considered, and then rejected, the possibility of running for the United States Senate.<sup>1</sup> Instead, she spent time as a commentator on the Cable News Network (CNN) issues forum *Crossfire*, a portion of her career that is not documented in her papers. Her aforementioned 1992 campaign was unsuccessful, but the Democratic Party picked up an important seat in the 1992 election, as William Jefferson Clinton was elected president. In January 1993, he appointed a member of the delegation to the United Nations Commission on Human Rights, based in Geneva, Switzerland. In 1998, she again declared her candidacy for the Democratic nomination as United States Senator from New York, but lost the primary to Charles Schumer.

The principle guiding the arrangement of this deposit was to maintain continuity with the previous deposit. Accordingly, this deposit comprises five series, organized as follows:

1. Articles. Box #208. This series contains five folders representing items Ferraro wrote for publication in the late 1980s and the 1990s.
2. Microfiche. Box #208. Ferraro's previous deposit contained four boxes of microfiche copies of her Congressional office papers. There were so few microfiche cards that were not duplicates that it seemed dangerous to store them outside the archive, lest they be lost altogether. Accordingly, they are stored with the papers.
3. Recordings. Boxes #208-#213. This series is subdivided. Six audiocassettes that did not come with their own plastic boxes and four micro cassettes are in document box along with the articles and microfiche. Twenty-nine audiocassettes in plastic boxes are in a separate box. Most of these cassettes were made after the 1984 vice presidential campaign and in the course of writing Ferraro's campaign memoir, *My Story*. In addition, there are four boxes of magnetic tape originally used in an IBM mainframe computer. The tapes contain information on the donors to Ferraro's 1992 Senate campaign. Marymount Manhattan College does not have facilities for reading the tapes.
4. Speeches. Boxes #214-224. The 501 speeches in this deposit are arranged chronologically. For each speech, the place at which it was delivered and the audience, if these are known, are noted on the label. Some speeches also have titles.
5. Subject. Boxes #224-226. Most of the eighty-five folders in this series concern the researching and writing of *My Story*. Other folders were discovered in the course of unpacking the boxes.
