

## **SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR MARYMOUNT MANHATTAN COLLEGE WELFARE BENEFITS PLAN**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Marymount Manhattan College Welfare Benefits Plan (Employer Identification Number 13-1628206, Plan Number 502) for the plan year 01/01/2016 through 12/31/2016. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

### **Insurance Information**

The plan has insurance contracts with Hartford Life Insurance Company, Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company and Aetna Life Insurance Company to pay all life insurance, short & long-term disability, accidental death & dismemberment, dental and health claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending 12/31/2016 were \$3,500,113.
