	The judicial officer failed to follow the College's judicial process.
	There is insufficient evidence to support the judicial officer's decision. (i.e., the facts presented, even if believed, are not sufficient to support the decision.)
	There is new information that was not reasonably available at the time of judicial
	meeting and the appeals officer believes the new information would have made a
	difference in the outcome.
	The judicial officer was biased. (i.e., incapable of impartially making a determination in the student's case)
	Release from Housing Contract Release from the contract is permitted only if the student is withdrawing from MMC at the end of the
	Release from the contract is permitted only if the student is withdrawing from MMC at the end of the semester or studying abroad. Please provide a detailed reason for your request.
	Appeal damage charges
	Appeals for damage charges can be submitted up to 30 days after the charge amounts are sent to your email account. Please explain which specific charge you are disputing and why.
	Request review of housing eligibility due to Judicial Probation
	Residents with restrictions on their housing eligibility due to judicial probation may apply for a review of thei status. Please explain why consideration should be given to change your eligibility status.
	Request to remain in housing under full-time status
	Residents that drop a class, during the semester, placing them below full-time status (12-Credits) may request to remain eligible to continue residing in the residence halls. Please explain the reason for dropping to part-time status.
