## Travel Notification Form

A nonimmigrant student may be readmitted after temporary absence of five months or less from the United States if otherwise admissible. The student may be readmitted by presenting a valid foreign passport, a valid visa, and either a new Form I-20 or a page 3 of the Form I-20 properly endorsed for reentry if the information on the I-20 form is current.

When you leave the United States, you must surrender your Form I-94 Departure Record. You do not have to turn in the I-94 if you are visiting Canada, Mexico, or adjacent islands other than Cuba for less than 30 days.

Please complete the below section and bring this to your Designated School Official to have page 3 of your Form I-20 signed. Upon return to the U.S., please see the ISS Office to ensure proper documentation.
