Required additional documentation

Student/Spouse expenses for private school (grammar/high school) tuition paid in 2017 for children :

- A copy of the 2017 tuition bill **OR** a statement on school letterhead, signed by school official outlining the amount of tuition paid in 2016.

Student/Spouse unreimbursed medical expenses:

- 2017 Schedule A from student/spouse tax return **OR** copies of all unreimbursed 2017 medical bills

Loss or decrease in student/spouse income through separation/divorce

- A copy of the separation agreement or letter from attorney stating the earliest date of students' separation (if the separation is not yet legal, submit proof that you are living in separate domiciles), or a copy of the divorce decree.

Loss of income due to death of spouse

- A copy of the death certificate of the deceased

Loss of income due to loss of employment or disability

- A copy of letter that notes the last date of employment on company letterhead and signed by a company official
- A copy of the most recent pay stub
- A copy of the unemployment benefits statement including the amount of payments remaining
- A copy of disability benefits receipt (if applicable)
