


TouchNet App (Android) installation Guide



Open the Google Play store.

Search "TouchNet OneCard".





Click "Install"

Click the button that says open, navigate to the app section of your phone to find the newly installed Touchnet OneCard App.



The App will open and the One Card VIP Splash screen will load




The app will load and ask to share your location

It asks this so it can tell where you are on campus and allow you to perform mobile swipes for access and meal plan usage.

It will also ask for permission for access to phone features, we recommend allowing this permission.






The app will then load the End User License Agreement.


You should look over this and then toggle the "I agree" button, to continue using the app.

Search for Marymount Manhattan College

You can use "MMC" or "Mar"

Tap on Marymount Manhattan College





Here is the default login screen.


TouchNet OneWeb)

If your phone has a fingerprint reader, you will be aked if you'd like to allow Touchnet Onecard to use it as a login permission.

You can select Allow or Don't Allow

If you do not currently have fingerprint credentials stored on your phone this will not work.

You must have fingerprint ID stored on your phone for Fingerprint ID to work



You may need to manually set the permissions of the App.

To check these features:

Click settings>App Settings>Select TouchNet Oncard>click on App info>App Permissions

You will now have full access to the TouchNet One card App
