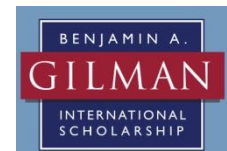

## JULY 2019

### **FULBRIGHT, BOREN, & MARSHALL**

All students interested in AY 2020-21 Fulbright, Boren, and Marshall awards must complete the respective Pre-Application Forms and return them, along with all requested supplementary documentation, to Prof. Bell by 1 July 2020. For copies of the forms, see this website: <http://www.mmm.edu/academics/external-scholarships-fulbright-and-boren-awards.php>. Students who miss this deadline may be able to pursue one of these grants but they may not have sufficient time to construct a competitive application.

### **FULBRIGHT**

- Draft your Statement of Grant Purpose and Personal Statement.

### **MARSHALL**

Candidates for AY 2020-22 Marshall Scholarships

- Late August: Submit final copies of your application to your Faculty Adviser and Prof. Bell for final review

### **GILMAN**

For Spring 2020 applications

- Mid-August: online application opens for Spring 2020 study-abroad programs and internships

## SEPTEMBER 2019

### **FULBRIGHT**

NB: Students who decide in early September that they want to apply for a Fulbright ETA award for the following year are free to proceed with their plans but will not receive the assistance or endorsement of the Campus Evaluation Committee. All candidates must have met the July 2019 deadline to submit their Pre-Application form to the Director of External Student Scholarships.

## SEPTEMBER 2019, continued

### FULBRIGHT

Candidates for AY 2020-21 ETA awards

- **Monday, 9 September: On-Campus Deadline for AY 2020-21 Fulbright awards.** Email one (1) copy of your final application to Prof. Bell, who will circulate copies to the Campus Evaluation Committee (CEC).
- 25 September: Campus Evaluations (interviews) for students not studying abroad in FA19. Prof. Bell, in consultation with the CEC, submits online evaluations of all candidates.

### BOREN

Candidates for AY 2020-21 Boren Scholarships

- Continue to work on application, including drafts of Statement of Grant Purpose and Personal Statement
- Continue to seek advice from Faculty Adviser, Prof. Bell, and CAST (Center for Academic Support and Tutoring)
- Consider continuing (during the Fall semester) language study for the country to which you are applying

### MARSHALL

Candidates for AY 2020-22 Marshall Scholarships

- **Monday, 9 September: Campus Deadline for AY 2020-22 Marshall Scholarships.** Email one (1) copy of completed application to Prof. Bell for her files. All recommendations are submitted online by 30 September.

## OCTOBER 2019

### FULBRIGHT

For AY 2020-21 ETA awards

- **8 October: National Deadline for AY 2020-21 Fulbright ETA awards.** Application materials, including reference forms, must have been submitted electronically. The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all reference forms have been uploaded to the OKTA/IIE system. No further changes to your application are permitted after this date.
- 10 October: Prof. Bell uploads Campus Committee Evaluation to OKTA/IIE website.

### BOREN

Candidates for AY 2020-21 Boren Scholarships

- Continue to work on application. Give revised copies to your Faculty Adviser, to Prof. Bell, and to CAST for feed-back and revisions. Continue language study.
- **15 October:** by this date, candidates must inform Prof. Bell of their desire to begin a Boren application for AY 2020-21 study abroad. Candidates who miss this deadline may pursue an application but might not receive guidance from Prof. Bell.

### MARSHALL

Candidates for AY 2020-22 Marshall Scholarships

- **1 October: Deadline for the submission of AY 2020-22 Marshall Scholarship applications.** Submit application on the online form provided. Applications must be endorsed by the President, Provost, or Academic Dean of the applicant's US educational institution (or employer). The online application is authorized by Prof. Bell. Prof. Bell sends academic transcripts (1 original) to the regional center by 3 October. Prof. Bell tracks and monitors the application's progress online.
- Applications are received and reviewed at regional centers.
- Late October: Mock interviews at MMC for candidates whose applications have been short-listed and who are called for an interview with the Marshall Scholarships committee.

### GILMAN

For Spring 2020 grants

- Late November: All Applicants are notified of the status of their application via email. Study Abroad and Financial Aid Advisors will be notified of scholarship recipients via email. A list of the recipients will be available on the Gilman website.

### MARSHALL

Candidates for AY 2020-22 Marshall Scholarships

- ca. 5 November: Interviews held in New York for short-listed candidates. (Dates of interviews at other regional centers are found online.) The final selection of candidates is announced shortly after the interview. Successful applicants will be offered a scholarship in writing and will be asked to accept or decline this offer, also in writing, within 10-12 days of receiving it. This timeframe may be shorter where the interviews occur late in the interview week. In keeping with other UK government-funded programs, the Marshall Commission asks Scholars to give a definitive and final response in this way, so that the Commission can at the earliest opportunity arrange the best and most appropriate graduate program and living accommodation for each Scholar's needs.

- Make a note of deadlines: Campus Deadline vs. National Deadline. Reference letters must be submitted by the Campus Deadline.

### BOREN

- Familiarize yourself with Boren Scholarship application.
