


Content Quick-Start Guide: MMC Brightspace

The **Content** tool allows you to upload and organize course materials such as your course SYLLABUS. You can incorporate a variety of activities into your materials and divide your course by units and lessons.

Creating Units, Lessons, and Folders

The Content tool is fundamentally organized as a series of units (i.e., modules) and lessons/folders (i.e., submodules within a unit) that you can create. This unit-based organization allows you to divide your course into smaller, logical sections, such as a week-based or topic-based delivery.



To create this organization in your course:

- Units -- Click the + New Unit link in top-left of the Content tool.
- Lessons -- Click Create New within a unit, then select the option for Lesson.

• Folders -- Click Create New within a lesson, then select the option for Folder.

You will then be able to give your unit, lesson, or folder a name and provide a description within the rich-text

Creating a Syllabus / Adding Content

If you would like to add your syllabus or other content, there are a variety of ways you can add this material within the Content tool.

HTML Documents

If you would like to type your content directly or copy/paste from a document or other application, you can do so within an HTML Document. To add an HTML Document:

1. Within a unit/lesson/folder, click **Create New**, then click **HTML Document**.

2. Enter a **Title** and then enter or paste your desired content in the **Description**

rich-text editor.

3. When finished, click **Save**.

The content will now display directly within Content as an embedded rich-text item.

PDFs, Word Documents, Images, and Other Files

If you already have files that you would like to upload and include in your course's content, you can upload these directly. To add a file:

1. Within a unit/lesson/folder, click Add Existing.

2. In the **Drag and Drop** section on the screen, drag any files that you would like to upload, or click on **Browse** to select the file from your computer.

Once added, these files will display as distinct items in the unit/lesson/folder.

Adding Other Activities

Beyond files and content, you can also incorporate other course materials and activities from elsewhere in your course directly into your Content structure. This includes:

- Assignments
- Discussions
- External Tools (e.g., Google Documents, VoiceThread activities, etc.)
- Youtube Stream videos
- Quizzes
- SCORM (Sharable Content Object Reference Model)

To add these, click on Add Existing or Create New.
